

## Transfer and Visiting Criteria

A student who has successfully completed the first year at a law school approved by the American Bar Association and who has met all requirements for admission, may be admitted as a transfer student. Transfer students must present a letter from the Dean of the law school last attended certifying the student's eligibility for admission or continued enrollment at that law school. An official transcript must be submitted directly from the law school attended.

- Students who have been excluded from other law schools because of scholastic deficiencies will not be admitted as a transfer.
- Southern University Law Center reserves the right to refuse credits, in whole or in part. Credit is transferable for courses in which the student earned a "C" or better.

Visiting students are accepted for summer, fall and spring. Applications are required as well as a letter of good standing from the Dean certifying approval to visit and the number of credits transferable.
