

Library Resources

The law library supports of the curriculum and research needs of a diverse patron group of students, faculty and the local legal community.

The library provides a variety of patron space including 222 study spaces in two study rooms, 4 reading rooms, and 43 carrels.

With more than 400,000 shelved volumes and 211,700 volume equivalents on microfiche, the library contains all federal and state judicial opinions and statutory codes, law reviews from every American law school, as well as access to the Federal Register and Code of Federal Regulations.

Two computer labs and wireless internet offer instant access to online databases, such as LexisNexis, Westlaw, Hein Online, LegalTrac, and Making of Modern Law (MOML). The collection is further enhanced through membership in the Louisiana Online University Information System (LOUIS) consortium.
